A Kingdom Legacy (Week 5)

Worship:

Song Suggestion: *I've Witnessed Your Faithfulness*
– *Passion*

As you worship, be specific in thanking God for His faithfulness.

Check-in:

Legacy is about what lives beyond us. Take a moment to share:

- Who has left a spiritual legacy that has impacted your life?

Synopsis of message:

This week we closed our **Heart for the Kingdom** series with a powerful reminder: **Legacy is not built in a day, but in daily decisions.**

Psalm 112:6 says, *“Surely the righteous will never be shaken; they will be remembered forever.”*

Legacy isn't about fame or possessions – it's about living for what lasts: God's Kingdom. When your life is lived for the Kingdom, your legacy will outlast your days.

Key Themes:

1. Legacy People Think Eternally

- They see beyond comfort and convenience.
- They live with an eternal mindset (*2 Corinthians 4:18; John 4:35*).

2. Legacy People Understand Sacrifice

- They choose to do less for themselves so they can do more for others.
- Sacrificial generosity invests in eternity (*Matthew 6:19–20*).

3. Legacy People Sense Urgency

- They don't wait for “one day” – they act today (*Ephesians 5:15–16*).
- Legacy is built through small, faithful “today” moments.

Bottom Line: What we do for ourselves dies with us. What we do for others, lives beyond us.

Scripture Focus:

- Psalm 112:5–6
- Matthew 6:19–21
- 2 Corinthians 4:18
- John 4:35
- Hebrews 6:10
- Ephesians 5:15–16

Discussion Questions:

1. Eternal Perspective

- How does thinking eternally change the way you live today?
- What does it mean to “fix your eyes on what is unseen” in practical terms?

2. Sacrificial Generosity

- Why is sacrifice essential to leaving a Kingdom legacy?
- What is one area where God might be calling you to live more open-handed?

3. Urgency and Action

- What's one “today” step you can take to live for the Kingdom?
- How can this group encourage each other to act now, not “one day”?

4. Heart for the Kingdom Offering

- How does giving become an act of worship rather than obligation?
- What excites you most about the vision for 2026 and beyond?

HEART FOR THE KINGDOM

Prayer Moment:

- Thank God for His faithfulness over the last year – be specific.
- Break Bread together and thank Jesus for his sacrificial generosity in giving up His life so that we and others might live.
- Pray: *“Lord, help me live with an eternal mindset, a sacrificial heart, and a sense of urgency.”*
- Pray for the Heart for the Kingdom Offering – that it would advance God’s mission and bless others.
- Ask God to strengthen our faith as we step into the Jubilee year **By Faith**.

Next Step:

This week, I will:

- Take one intentional step toward living a Kingdom legacy (e.g., generosity, serving, sharing faith).
- Pray daily: *“God, help me live today in a way that will be remembered for eternity.”*
